Public transport

Public transport in Prague is a fast and reliable way to get around, especially in the city center. Tickets are valid for buses, trams, trolleybuses, metro, ferries, and trains, allowing unlimited travel within the selected time period. The metro is ideal for covering longer distances, while trams are perfect for navigating the city center.

One way to buy a bus or tram ticket is directly on board the vehicle at a contactless (only) payment terminal. The ticket is valid from the moment of purchase and does not need to be validated.



The second option is to purchase tickets from ticket terminals located at metro stations and some surface transport stops. Tickets from these machines must be validated (stamped once) in a ticket validator before entering the metro platform or immediately after boarding a bus or tram!



Tickets are also available at information centers, ticket offices, and newsagents. Alternatively, you can use the PID Lítačka app (https://app.pidlitacka.cz/), which helps you find routes and purchase tickets. For connections, you can also visit the website: https://spojeni.dpp.cz/?cl=EN.

What to see and do in Prague

Touristic attractions near meeting venue.

Prague Castle is the largest ancient castle complex in the world. You can admire the stunning architecture, including St. Vitus Cathedral, Old Royal Palace, St. George's Basilica and Golden Lane.

Nový Svět (New World) is a charming neighborhood around Černínská and Nový Svět streets with picturesque houses and tranquil atmosphere.

Charles Bridge is the oldest Prague bridge. It is lined with statues and lamps and with the Gothic towers on both ends makes iconic medieval landmark.

Petřín Hill sometimes called a hill of lovers is one of the largest urban green areas. There is a lookout tower on the top. Funicular is out of order.

Kampa is an artificial island with two original mill wheels. It is a very nice and calm place to walk. There is Museum Kampa, a gallery of modern art.

₹ From/to the airport

Prague's Václav Havel Airport is connected to metro stations by buses. T-Bus 59 goes to Nádraží Veleslavín (metro green line A); Bus 100 goes to Zličín (metro yellow line B). Bus 907 and 910 connect the city centre with the airport at night. Standard fares apply.

Special tariffs apply to the Airport Express (AE) bus line, which runs from the airport to the main railway station and back. You can purchase tickets directly on the bus (CZK 100).

By car

Contact your hotel to inquire about parking options near your accommodation. We do not recommend using a car to travel around the city center, as it is crowded, busy, and parking is very difficult to find.

Parking on selected Prague streets has been divided up into zones. Avoid blue zones, as they are primarily for residents, and look for purple ones instead. Payment can be made via parking meters, mobile apps, or websites. Alternatively, you can use P+R car parks located on the outskirts of Prague. Be sure to check the maximum parking duration, which is usually limited to 24 hours.



By train

The Prague main railway station (Hlavní nádraží) is located in the city centre, directly on the metro station (red line C).

By bus

All main bus terminals are located on the metro stations, so you should not have problem to reach your accomodation/venue.
