

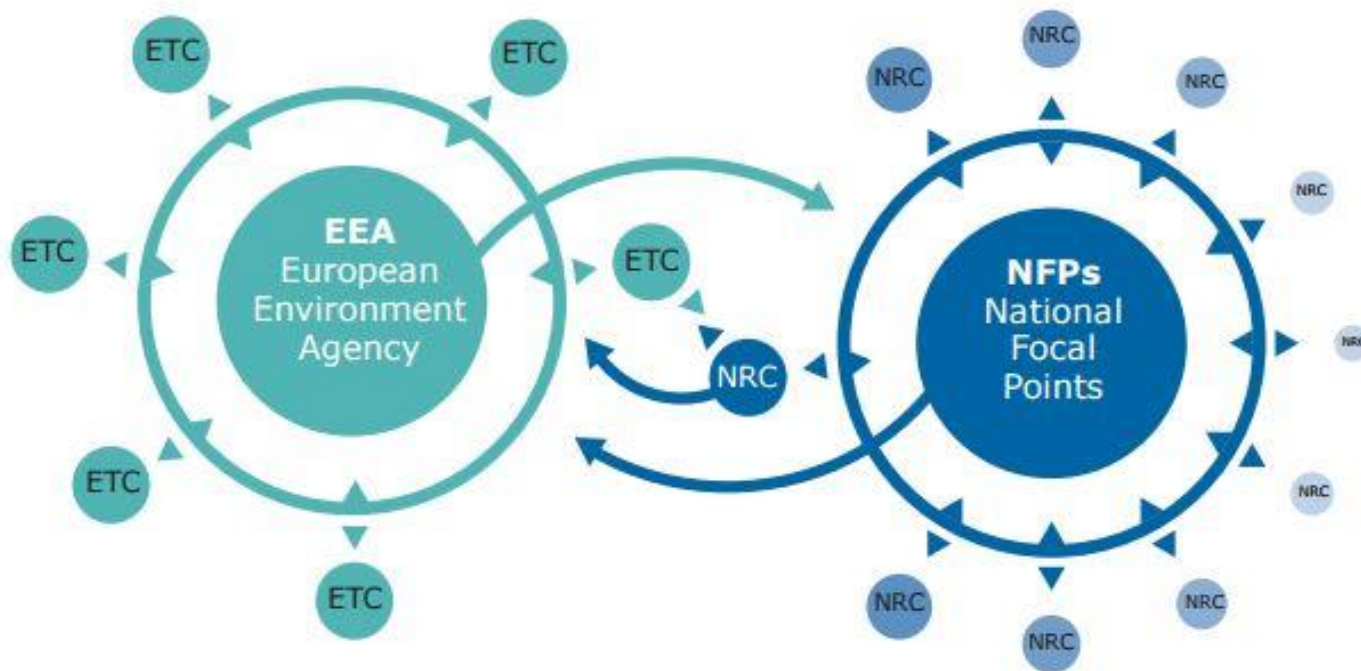

# EEA's Regulation and EIONET

- Set up by EEC Regulation 1210/1990 (amended by EC regulations 933/1999 and 1641/2003)
- The **European Environment Agency (EEA)** aims to help achieve significant and measurable improvement in Europe's environment and to support sustainable development through the provision of relevant, reliable, targeted and timely information to policy makers and the public.
- **European environment information and observation network (Eionet)**. About 350 national institutions in 33 member countries + collaborating countries, comprising:
  - National focal points (NFPs)
  - National reference centres (NRCs)
  - Other national institutions
  - European topic centres

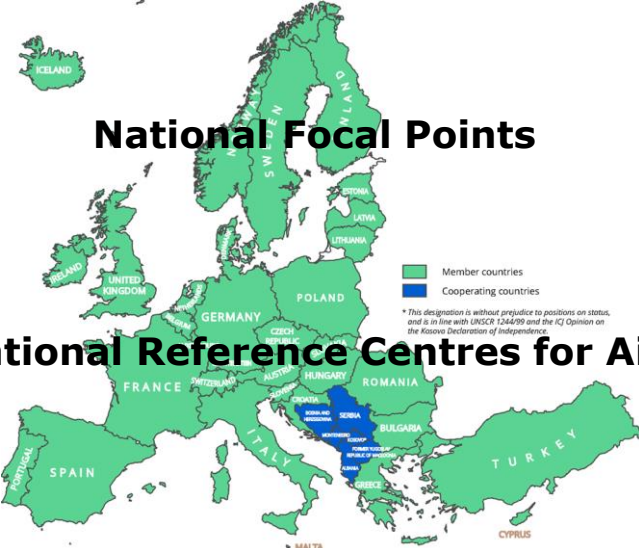

# EIONET and its links with FAIRMODE

## MEMBER COUNTRIES: modellers + users of models

- Assessment of air quality: zones, measurement, models
- Management of air quality:
  - Short term action plans
  - Plans to improve air quality (source allocation, effects of measures...)
- Information to the public
  - Air Quality indexes
  - Forecast

EIONET brings together some of the main potential users of models (EEA, AQ managers) with some of the model developers and groups (ETC/ACM, national models).
